Sentral is the name of the software that staff at Gilgandra High School use every day for tasks ranging from recording attendance, wellbeing, markbooks and reports.

## Student Portal

Student passwords are also changed in here.

The easiest way to get a copy of Office 2019 on your own computer is to log into the portal, visit the Microsoft Office 365 link in the Learning tab, and choose the 'Install Office' button.
